

This amendment was discussed at the September community meeting and will be voted on at the Community Meeting on October 12th at 7:30 in Si-Lounge. All community members are invited to attend and make their opinion known and to vote on this amendment.

Amendment to Operating Procedures

(Election of Community Coordinator)

Any person who desires to be a candidate for the Community Coordinator position shall:

1) Submit his/her name in writing as a candidate for that position to the current Community Coordinator before April 30th of the end of the current Community Coordinator's term. The candidate may include with his/her application a written statement, including experience, goals, or other appropriate matters relevant to his/her application.

2) The Community Coordinator shall present the application at the May Steering Committee and Community Meeting. The candidate will be confirmed at the June Community Meeting by a majority of the members present. The new Community Coordinator will assume the duties of the office on the first day of July.

3) If applications from more than one candidate for Community Coordinator are received, the Communication Coordinator will, within two weeks after the May Steering Committee Meeting, mail to the QAC membership the names of the candidates along with their written statements. The new Community Coordinator will be elected at the June Community Meeting by majority vote of the members present and the proxies. (Any QAC member unable to attend the June meeting may receive a proxy ballot from the current Community Coordinator and return the signed ballot to the Community Coordinator prior to the June Meeting.) The newly elected Community Coordinator will assume the duties of the office on the first day of July.

4) In the event a Community Coordinator is unable to continue in that capacity prior to the expiration of his/her term, a succeeding Community Coordinator shall be selected immediately in the same manner as described above. In the interim the Steering

| Committee shall appoint a temporary Community Coordinator, who will have all the rights and duties given to the Community Coordinator under the provisions of our Constitution and the Operating Procedures.

5) If by April 30th there are no candidates, the Steering Committee will appoint an interim coordinator until a coordinator comes forward.
